Enhanced cloud support



- > Launch developer clients from QPR UI & QPR Portal
- > Automatic user profile updates / new profile creation in QPR UI upon logging in to the same using federated authentication
- > Improved connection keepalive mechanism

Better performance



- > Choose whether QPR Metrics model elements are loaded by default as-needed, or all at once when opening a model
- > New/close connection entries are logged only in Full Trace Mode
- > Faster QPR UI queries

Improved reliability



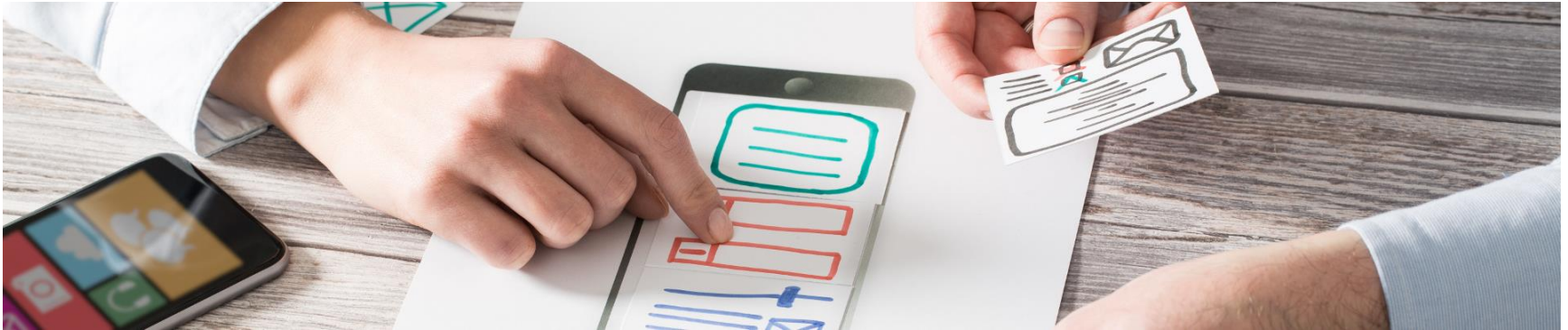
- More robust QPR Metrics Server transaction management: period deletions no longer produce errors
- Vertical scaling no longer shows incorrect or duplicate values in QPR Metrics dashboard charts
- Model unlocks if QPR Metrics thick client crashes or loses connection to QPR Metrics Server

Tightened security



- > User accounts no longer become invalid when using the '&' character in passwords set via QPR Portal settings
- > Edit button has been removed in QPR Portal for QPR Metrics viewer users
- > Passwords are no longer left empty for users created via the Web Service API

Better UX



- Cancel QPR Metrics measure deletions with the ESC key
- "Set as editable in web" setting under the QPR Metrics dashboard view no longer affects other dashboards
- QPR Metrics client now uses correct period levels for text box items in dashboard view
- Word wrapping now works with Internet Explorer when editing QPR Portal actions
- Clicking a subprocess element in QPR Portal while having the "Hide from diagram hierarchy" behavior set option turned on no longer opens an incorrect view
- Fixed empty Excel exports from the QPR Portal Metrics Navigator View
- Header row in the QPR Portal Metrics Navigator view no longer becomes invisible
- It's now possible to change the Input Type correctly on the QPR Metrics client Element Properties Series tab
- It's no longer possible to select an unsupported connector type due to better validation

Other improvements

- > Web Services support for a new `.references` relation attribute that returns an element's all reference element IDs
- > API command `PGModel.ImportElements` with `"ElementType=<type symbol>"` as an import parameter no longer adds additional elements to the target model
- > QPR Metrics client now stays hidden when using `"SetUIMode (0)"`
- > New templates
 - Open Group ArchiMate 3.0 (only for QPR EnterpriseArchitect)
 - OMG UML 2.5 (only for QPR EnterpriseArchitect)
 - APQC Process Classification Framework (PCF) 2017.1
