1 Overview

View Links in Flowchart shows *views* on top of the EA/PD flowchart, where they can be clicked to change views (see the demo image). This improves usability for certain use cases as all available views are visible and changing views is quicker, compared to using Views button.

2 Compatibility

Compatible with QPR 2015.1.

3 Installation

Installation steps:

1. Apply patch **FlowchartViewLinks.patch** to **C:\ProgramData\QPR Software\QPR 2015\2015.1\Servers\Templates\WAS** (or use already changed **jsflowchartutils.tpl**). (more information for changing templates: <https://community.qpr.com/node/1681>)
2. Add contents of **custom.css** to **C:\inetpub\wwwroot\qpr2015-1\qprsoftware\stylesheets\custom.css**.
3. Clear QPR Portal template cache, and clear web browser's cache.

4 Configuration

There are no mandatory settings to be configured. Still, the location of the views list can be adjusted by changing the **top** and **right** properties of **#divFlowchart #ViewsListInFlowchart** selector (clearing browser cache is needed after).
